The luxury of the land of Egypt would be impossible to describe in any wise at all. Language would fail any individual to describe the life of refined luxury the Egyptians were living at the time that Moses led the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt, but today, beloved, in contrast, the land of Egypt is a land of poverty. It is a land of hopeless bankruptcy.

That land, which once was so given over to wealth, is now a land of poverty, and whereas the people and the children who lived in the land of Egypt were once clothed in linen, now you would find there nothing but nakedness

and want.

So far as the land of Egypt is concerned politically, it is under the rule, at the present time, of England, but the land of Egypt has been under the rule of one country or another from the time that this passage of Scripture was





Cicero's 19year-old son is going along to visit relatives and help his father row the canoe back up stream. He has not been to Cruzeiro do Sul in 12 years and he is happy to go. Bro. Cicero's family and several others came down to see us off and we left for down river at 6:10 a. m. We stopped down stream to pick up the little crippled boy. As we landed at a sand beach the little fellow crawled down the bank. Bro. Mario went across the sand beach and picked him up and brought him in the boat. here on earth, the "Jews" as they were called, were composed of members of all the tribes. For instance, Anna the prophetess of Luke 2:36 was of the tribe of Asher. Let us note some Scriptures that make plain beyond question that the ten tribes were not lost in the time of Jesus and the apostles:

1. Paul identifies the Jews of that day with all the tribes, when he speaks of Israel. (Acts 13:17).

2. Paul speaks of the Jews as of

the twelve tribes. (Acts 26:6-7). 3. If the ten tribes were lost James didn't know it for he addressed the people of "the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad." (In the dispersion).

4. "Jews" and "Israelites" are one and the same, for the terms are used interchangeably in the Scriptures. For a case in point, see John 3:1 and 10.

These Scriptures could be multiplied indefinitely. Talk about the "lost tribes" is foolishness.

Anglo-Saxon People Are Not Israelites

The Israelites belong to a distinct branch of the human family -the Semitic branch. Anglo-Saxons are of an entirely different branch. They are Japhethites. Most of us are a "Duke's mixture" racially. We are not a pure blooded people, but a race of people blended from many nationalities. The Jews to the contrary have kept aloof from other races in the matter of marriage such that they retain their racial peculiarities.

Here are the facts. The Supper was instituted with one loaf of unleavened bread and one cup of fermented wine. In the New Testament it is always singular -CUP- not cups, until after it is blessed.
