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



Cruzeiro do Sul—Bro. Paul Calley plans to remove the partitions from this building and make it into a church building. This is the headquarters of our mission work in the Acre Territory. This is the place where so many have tried to interfere and take our work away from us. It seems to be the apple of the eye to so many. This is number six on the map. Bro. Paul Calley and family are to move there soon, the Lord willing.



This is number nine on the map. This is on the Parana Dos Mouros River, about a two-day journey by boat with autboard motor from Cruzeiro do Sul. This building was built by the man who owns the rubber plantation. He has been saved nine years and is now 84 years old and has 21 children. Cicero Bispo preaches here and also Efrazo Soares. When they are not there, two sons of the old man preach. This old man is a patriarch of his time in this place. This is a Sunday morning congregation of a rainy day. This is tiger country in the jungle.



After preaching on baptism, Bro. Royal Calley baptizes three men on a Sunday afternoon in a clear stream about an hours walk from Cruzeiro do Sul. A boy sits on a log across the stream to get a close-up look. There was a large crowd present at this baptizing, which are not shown in the picture. Number six on the map.



Arenal is a place where several Indian families live. This is a mission preaching point. The services are held in the open front room of this house which is usually well filled with several standing outside listening to the Word of God. This is inland from Astoria, a walk of about one hour. This is number fourteen on the map.




This is the congregation after a Sunday morning service. Morapirango is inland from the Moa River about one hours walk. Bro. Francisco Lima preaches to this congregation. It is number seven on the map. This building sets out in a large clearing in the jungle.




Campo de Santano is 125 miles up the Jurua River above Cruzeiro do Sul and can only be reached by boat. It is three to four days journey by outboard motored canoe. This is really back in the jungle. Cicero Bispo is the pastor and he and family live, here on the bank of the Jurua River. These people came in the afternoon before the night service to get in the picture. This is number ten on the map.




First Baptist Church, Iquitos, Peru. This is a beautiful building built of brick and plastered inside and out and beautifully painted. It has a tile roof and the best of our mission church buildings. This is where Bro. R. P. Hallum and family, and Bro. M. E. Lewis and family live and where Bro. C. W. Hunter and family are to soon go, the Lord willing. This is a small church but well indoctrinated and the only real Baptist Church in this city of over 50,000 population. Number twelve on the map.



Polis is on Polis Creek. To get here by canoe one leaves lquitos in Lake Morona Cocha, then down the Nanay River, then up the Momon River, and then up Polis Creek. This is the home of a great Peruvian Baptist layman, Adolfo Nunes. The services are held in this house and the missionary sleeps on the floor. The cows can walk under the house. This is a hard days journey by outboard motored canoe from Iquitos. Part of the year this place cannot be reached because of low water. This is number fifteen on the map.



The pastor of the church at Japiim is Mario Araujo. He once was a Catholic and a terrible persecutor of the Baptists. Japiim is a very beautiful place on the Japiim River. Number eight on the map. Pastor Mario is standing in the door. This is a one-day journey by cance with outboard motor from Cruzeiro do Sul.



Amonho, Acre, Brazil—This is the church building in Amonho, 255 miles up the Jurua River above Cruzeiro do Sul. There are several rapids in the river before one gets there and the trip cannot be made with outboard motor when the water is low. This is a small church with only a few members. Cicero Bispo visits and preaches to them a few times a year. He has two married daughters who live there. With the exception of some preaching points far in, this is the back side of the jungle. This is number eleven on the map.



This is number thirteen on the map and is a mission point where the Gospel is preached in the largest house in the group. This is on the bank of the Amazon River at the mouth of the Nanay River, and is about a two-hour journey from Iquitos, Peru by outboard motored canoe. When the missionaries go here they sleep on the floor in the house on the right of the picture. The water is very high in the river at the time this picture was taken.



Mapa Cocha is a mission preaching point on the Nanay River above Iquitos. This is an Indian village and there are at least 50 men who live in this village. The preaching is always well attended. Most all the houses have dirt floors. Only a few are built off the ground. There are a few believers at this place. This is number 16 on the map. These pictures give you a good idea of how your mission money is used for spreading the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.


