> A song is sinful if it teaches salvation from sin by human works. A song is sinul if it teaches the God-dishonoring doctrine of "falling from grace" or losing one's salvation after one has been truly saved by God's

Note especially the second line:

Pay the price for what? Why, the price of "going thru" or staying saved! What is that price according to this song? It is to "keep pace" (stanza two), it is to endure hardship (stanza three), it is not to "shrink from the pathway" (stanza three). In other words, to stay saved, we must work very hard. Otherwise we will fail to go thru.'

In what languages was the Bible first written? Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek.

Where are the original copies of the Bible?

The original manuscripts of the Hebrew Old Tes ment and of the Greek Gospels and Epistles, etc., proba have all been worn out and discarded long ago. Con were made by hand, used, recopied and discarded over over again.

But in 1947 the entire book of Isaiah, with the exc tion of two very small breaks, was discovered in a northwest of the Dead Sea. The parchment had been den in an earthenware jar, wrapped in yards of cloth covered with pitch. It is considered by experts to have b written during the first century B. C., fully 1,000 y before the oldest previously known Hebrew manuscrip a book of the Bible. The evidence points to the fact ! this manuscript of Isaiah was undoubtedly in use Christ was living. A few manuscripts since discove may be even older.

The oldest Greek manuscripts of larger parts of Bible are the Codex Sinaiticus, now in the British seum, and the Codex Vaticanus, now in the Vatica These were probably written in the fourth century contain the Greek text of nearly the whole Bible.

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
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AS ONE OF OUR READERS WISHES TO SEE US
