Dear friends:

New Guinea, in the name of our Lord. Trusting that this finds each of you enjoying the blessings of our mighty God. We are doing just fine over on this side of the world, having plenty to enjoy and much more than we deserve.

We are having near normal rainfall over all the island now, and the sweet-potato gardens and other food stuffs have started growing once again. In most areas however, it will be as much as five months before the people start realizing anything out of their gardens to eat. In the meantime, upwards of 150,000 people are having to get their daily handouts in rice and fish in order to survive.

The change in diet has brought its side effects to the people of this area. It is most likely that less than five percent of the people know anything at all about washing food and properly pre-

To make this sort of stretch over the week a can will be opened and in many cases it will be only partially eaten. 

There is not enough water in all three of these verses in which to baptize a gnat. So if baptism is essential to salvation, these verses are not only false, they are misleading and dangerous.




