
DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT DO ANY BAPTIZING?



The singing of hymns in the churches is a practice which dates back to the infancy of the church. There were many hymns written in the first and second centuries. The oldest hymn now known among Christians is, "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost, World Without End, Amen." It was doubtless written by one who was in principle and practice a Baptist. It was first given to the churches in the second century, or earlier. The additional words, "As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be," were placed in this sacred song at an early period.

Baptists no longer write great hymns like they used to do. It seems we have turned the job over to other denominations, especially the Pentecostals. Most hymnbooks in our Baptist churches are filled with unscriptural songs. We need a revival of the singing of the old Baptist hymns in our churches. May it please the Lord to raise up one to gather these old Baptist hymns and put them in a new hymnbook to be used by our people.





GOD SPEAKS WITH PURPOSE

It is not without foresight, purdeclares through Isaiah, "If they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them." We have earlier noted that God is here speaking of "those who have familiar spirits (mediums), and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter." Very simply, God enunciates for all who will listen that wizards, mediums, astrologers, soothsayers, and other fortune-tellers, by whatever name, are His enemies and the servants of Satan "the father of lies!"

It is not improbable that some who are "hooked" - and it is that, because for the lost it is demon possession, and for the saved it is demonic regression, and perhaps "a sin unto death" - on the satanic spiritism of mediums, (Continued on page 7, column 5)

I then told him that I would appreciate it very much if he would harmonize the Holy Spirit baptism with Ephesians 4:5 when he came back the next week, because I was having trouble with it. He very kindly consented to do it. But now some twenty years later, he has never done it I do not want to be dogmatic and say it cannot be done. So I will just say that so far as I am able to see there is just no way to do it.

Our Lord had quite a lot to say about what the Holy Spirit would do when He came. He is to abide in us forever, John 14:16. He reproves the world of sin, of righteousness, and of judgment, John 16:8. He is to teach us what Christ has said, John 14:26. He guides us into all truth, John 16:13. He glorifies Christ, John 16:14. There are so many other things that He does for us. But if Christ said anything about His baptizing people I failed to catch it. There are those who hold that the Holy Spirit baptizes us into Christ in Galatians 3:27. But I hold that the church does that. There is nothing said in this verse about the Holy Spirit doing the baptizing. But Ephesians 4:5 does say there is just one baptism. By this is meant there is just one kind of baptism.

When people get this so-called baptism by the Holy Spirit and start speaking in the so-called unknown tongues which the original Bible does not so much as mention, they seem to lose all control of themselves. 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

Eternal life and death are in view here. There is a relationship between eternal realities and temporal manifestations. This verse is not a recipe for the obtaining of life, but a test of its forth in verses 28-39, this assurpossession, and an encouragement of its manifestation.

Genuine believers in Christ will never die (Jn. 11:26). Having received eternal life as "the gift of God" (Rom. 6:23), they will by His indwelling Spirit keep on killing the deeds of the body, and so will continue to live. People who "live after the flesh," no matter what they profess, show by their conduct that they are still under the rule of darkness and death. (I Jn. 2:4).
